Jack Humphreville has contributed over 700 articles to City Watch where he has commented on the Department of Water & Power and the finances of the City of Los Angeles. He wrote the Opposition Argument in 2009 to Measure B, Mayor Villaraigosa's plan to install 400 megawatts of solar power in metropolitan Los Angeles, and Proposition A, the 2013 proposal to increase the City's sales tax by a half cent to 9.5%. **Voters rejected both measures.**

He was also an early proponent of an independent Ratepayers Advocate to oversee DWP's rates that were later approved by 78% of the voters in 2011. Jack is a member of the Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council and chairman of the DWP (Advocacy) Committee. Jack is a graduate of Harvard College and Harvard Business School. Prior to joining his current employer, Target Media Partners, he was an investment banker.
